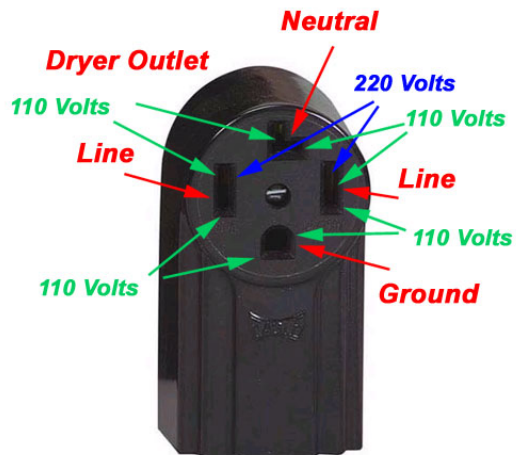
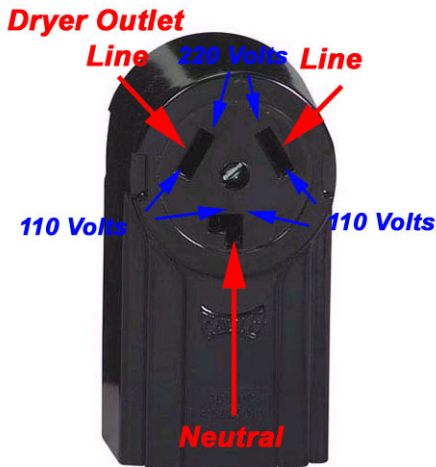




Below are the 3 options on the electrical outlets we can use and some pictures of the different outlets.

### Option # 1

The 1st 2 pictures below are dryer Outlets. I cannot use these outlets.



The next 2 plugs below are stove outlets. I can use either one of these outlets. I can use 3 prongs or 4 prongs just so they are within 100 feet of the stage area. We prefer the 4 prong plug if possible. However the 3 prong plug may be used.

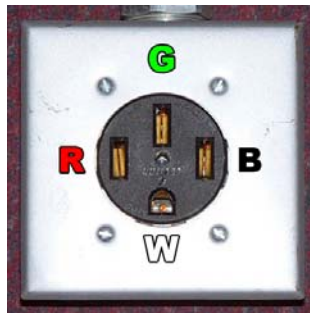


## Option # 2

Below are pictures of my pigtail that I bring with me that you can hook into your fuse box on a 40 or 50 amp circuit. I would need someone from your church that knows what they are doing to hook this in before the event. Usually this should be done about one hour after setup begins.



**Red = Hot   Black = Hot   White = Neutral   Green = Ground**



## Option # 3

I can run extension cords around the building to 5 different circuits. I would need to know how the outlets in the building are divided into circuits. If I plug in too much of my equipment into one circuit it will blow a fuse. In some buildings all the outlets in a room are on one circuit.

**We prefer Option one or two. Option # three should only be a last resort if options one or two absolutely cannot be used.**
